After the welcome Kai announced the changes in the MJC ICM (new president Michael Sander) and EBICM (new voting system as agreed at the last EBICM meeting in Vienna 2017).

The group discussed the ETR ICM and highlighted that a (new) Version 2.0 could be of possible benefit for promoting minimum standards across Europe.

To do so all primary specialties should be contacted and involved in this process. It is of note that so far, we have not succeeded to have all involved primary specialties at the table during our meetings, despite invitations. All agree that efforts should be done to make this work.

Also it was discussed to transform the ETR in a sort of "Diploma". The EDIC of ESICM or EDAIC of ESA is not (yet) a diploma to allow free movement of professionals in Europe.

Fellowships in ICM were also considered within the group as well as quality and quantity of nurses in the ICU setting.

Finally, all agreed to define a mission statement for EBICM and a new roadmap for the near future. Kai was thanking everybody and handed over the position of the President of the MJC ICM after 5 years to Michael.

The meeting was closed by Massimo and Kai.

The next meeting of the Multidisciplinary Joint Committee Intensive Care Medicine and the EBICM will be in Paris, October 20th 2018. It is necessary to elect members from the disciplines Cardiac surgery, Cardiology, Internal medicine, Neurology
